

BY-LAW 10

ATHLETICS

Part I: General

1. EngSoc shall offer a program of athletic awards based on participation in intramural and extramural athletics as a means of encouraging the involvement of its members in athletics.
2. In any case of a conflict between this by-law and the rules established by the various governing bodies of athletics at the University, the latter shall prevail.

Part II: Engineering Athletics Representatives

3. There Engineering Society Athletics Representatives shall be responsible for organizing intramural athletics for all Engineering athletics teams. They will also organize athletic events open to all Engineering Society members.
4. The Athletics Representatives will be organized in a two-year rotating system, in which the existing Athletics Representative shall train the newly appointed representative.
5. The Athletics Representative (BEWS) shall be appointed by the EngSoc Council on the basis of appointments as seen in Policy Manual Section γ .A Appointments, and shall hold office for a term of two years.
6. The Athletics Representative (WIC) shall be appointed by the EngSoc Council on the basis of appointments as seen in Policy Manual Section γ .A Appointments, and shall hold office for a term of two years.
