

BY-LAW 7

ACADEMIC REPRESENTATIVES

Part I: Faculty Board Members

1. Student membership on the Faculty Board of the Faculty of Applied Science exists under the Rules of Procedure of that body, and such rules shall be the definitive authority on matters respecting student representation on the Board.
2. The student members of the Faculty Board shall represent the interests of the students in Applied Science, and shall be expected to take an active interest in the business of the Board and in related matters.

Part II: Senators

3. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of Senate, and with the membership as defined by the Board of Trustees, the Engineering Society shall be represented on Senate as provided in this by-law.

Part III: Student Representatives to Faculty Board

4. There shall be a total of ten (10) student members of the Faculty Board, of which five (5) shall be ex-officio and five (5) shall be elected.
5. The ex-officio student membership shall include the two EngSoc student members to Senate, the President of EngSoc, the Vice-President (Student Development) of EngSoc, and the Vice-President (Academic). This membership is controlled by the Rules of Procedure of the Faculty Board.
6.
 - a. The five(5) elected representatives shall be intramural students in the Faculty of Applied Science.
 - b. They shall be elected annually at the Year Society elections as provided below, and shall serve for a one year term, eligible for re-election if qualified.
 - c. The five (5) positions shall be distributed among the various Years as follows:
 - i. two persons elected from the second-year class,
 - ii. one person elected from the third-year class,
 - iii. one person elected from the fourth-year class,
 - iv. one person elected from the first-year class.
7. There shall exist a Student Caucus of the Faculty Board, which shall consist of all student members of the Board, and shall be chaired by the Vice President (Academic).
8. The Caucus shall meet from time to time at the call of its Chair.

Part IV: Student Representatives to Senate

9. There shall be two student Senators who shall be members of the Engineering Society, serving two-year terms and retiring alternate years.

10. The student representatives to Senate shall represent the Engineering Society on the Student Senate Caucus
